If a travel visa is not approved 30 days prior to the camp start date, J. Addison School will refund the full payment within one month after withholding CAD\$200 handling fee per student. The official rejection letter from the Canadian Embassy and a written refund request to the school must be submitted. Cancellation requests due to any other nature within 30 days prior to the camp start date will not be eligible for refund. All fees paid are non-refundable and non-transferable. 5. Residence Security / Damage Deposit Policy The Security / Damage Deposit is held in trust to ensure coverage of the cost of repairs and/or replacements in relation to any damages that may occur to J. Addison School's Residence / property and all of its contents during the student's stay. Cleaning costs will be deducted from the deposit if the student's room requires excessive cleaning.
