--Look at the story "Yesterday" by Haruki Murakami or the story you chose for your essay and evaluate it from a feminist perspective using the answers from your questions to analyze the message being sent by the author about women in the story.

--Your analysis should be 3 paragraphs (one per question) and you must draw a conclusion regarding how the author views women from what they wrote in the story.
