### **How does it work?**

Each course contains instructional content that covers all the Ontario curriculum expectations and has been carefully designed by J. Addison teaching staff. All of our teachers are experienced, qualified teachers in their respective fields. Assignments and quizzes appear throughout the course content. Students submit their answers and written assignments online. There are interactive activities and multimedia elements throughout the content to engage students, provide opportunities to practice understanding, and differentiate instruction. The assignments are submitted online to your respective teachers online. Any tests or quizzes will be open-book and completed online. **Should we not return on April 6, 2020 the final exam is also completed online under the supervision of your respective subject teacher. The date and time, of the exam will be June 8 to 12, 2020.** Once the course is finished, J. Addison School will issue report cards and all results will be added to the student's transcripts and sent to OSR (Ontario Student Record) and send to the post-secondary institution for those students who have applied to university.

**Students are expected to login daily** to their online classes in order to ensure they are accessing their daily class work and assignments.

## Will these courses count towards my diploma or university application?

Yes, J. Addison School is inspected by the Ontario Ministry of Education and is qualified to issue OSSD credits.

## How long does a course take?

Students have up to June 8, 2020 in which to complete their courses. All course outlines indicates that the course will take 110 hours and highlights the breakdown of each unit. Please keep in mind that the 110 hours reflect the number of hours a student may spend on the lessons and does not include additional time students may take to complete assignments or prepare for tests or examinations.

## Are the online course credits recognized by universities and colleges?

At J. Addison School, online courses earn OSSD credits, which are the same credits that a student would earn in a bricks-and-mortar school in Ontario. As a result, these credits will not be viewed any differently by post-secondary institutions.

### How do I communicate with my teacher?

You will communicate with your teacher primarily through email within the online learning environment. [Google Classroom](#) and [J. Addison School's website](#) are the primary modes of delivering the course contents. However, other modes of communication such as telephone or video conferencing may be arranged upon request and at the teacher's discretion. J. Addison has required that teachers log in daily to respond to emails and address inquiries. **Teachers will monitor submissions and communications with you and remind you of any missed and/or upcoming deadlines.** They will also remind Mr. Pat and Mr. Venditti. To ensure a successful learning experience by practicing proactive course management strategies, teachers will post a message or announcement to their class at least once a week, to tell students what they will be covering in the coming week and to remind them of any due dates.

### Will J. Addison continue to inform OUAC/OCAS or the university know that I am taking a courses online with J. Addison?

When a student reaches midterm or final point in a course, J. Addison will send that information to OUAC, OCAS, and/or to any post-secondary institution upon the student's request. J. Addison has the student's post-secondary record on file, and any other future updates regarding your progress (i.e. midterm or final report cards) will be forwarded accordingly. However, it is always beneficial to double-check that the grade has been updated when you reach the midterm or final point in the course.

### When can I write the final exam?

The student will write the exam from June 8 to 12, 2020. Assignments and tests **MUST** be completed at the time before the exam. Any assignments not received by the teacher prior to the exam may be graded a zero.
