## 1 Minute Animation (1:30 min. MAX)

Now that you have tried 4 different materials/ways, and ideas, to make 'Stop Motion' films, choose one (1) you like working with. Whether it is the IDEA or the MATERIAL, from your first (1<sup>st</sup>) short films, choose to work with what seemed easier for you and make a longer Animated film using that material, or idea! Expand on it .... OR, try something completely NEW!

Start again, add more characters, or actions, etc..

It is best to work with something YOU KNOW! Get your family involved!

### Remember, Artists get their ideas from,

- > The world around them (Observations), such as from nature, objects, people, OR a material exploration, like the example of clay-mation below.
- Memories, such as a feeling; a person, place, or thing (nouns)
- Imagination your own creation, OR from existing fantastic stories from adventures, or another world, fairy tales, poems, science fiction, utopian, from ancient times, etc
- Reference Materials photos, comics, the news, films, etc.

# <u>NOTE: do not copy stories or characters from another PERSON's art work, or film, unless you change it in some way!!</u> etc. Be inspired! Do not copy!

#### **Criteria For Success:**

- ✓ 1 minute (60 secs x 24 fps (frames per sec)) 1:30 min. MAX
- ✓ Title shown at beginning
- ✓ Credits (beginning or end of film)— Who did what? Character design, Camera person, Lighting person, Background Setting person? Etc..
