## J. Addison School Quarantine Requirements

As you may or may not be aware, under the current Canadian government policies, all travellers arriving in Canada are subjected to a mandatory 14-day self-quarantine period. This means that all J. Addison students flying into Canada to start their 2020-21 academic program will need to arrive at least 14 days in advance and make living arrangements to quarantine for 14 days before they can move into J. Addison School's dormitory and/or start attending school.

## Day students

Day students are responsible to make their own arrangement for the 14 day self-quarantine period and the costs involved. We will be asking students to provide and show us their boarding pass(es) and/or stamped travel documents stating the date of their return or arrival to Canada.

## **Dorm Students**

Dorm students may choose to make their own arrangements for the 14 day self-quarantine period at their own costs. We will be asking students to provide and show us their boarding pass(es) and/or stamped travel documents stating the date of their return or arrival to Canada before moving in to our dormitory. Alternatively, dorm students may request for school arranged quarantine services.

## Fees for Quarantine Services provided by our school:

A \$250 one-time fee will be charged for all school arranged quarantine services.

For dorm students who are requesting early move-in to allow extra time for self-isolation, they must contact us well in advance to request these arrangements. Please note these arrangements are limited to a first-come-firstserved basis. Extra fees will incur for early move-ins.

\$75/night for early move-in days on-site (based on number of days that a private dorm is needed, with the minimum of 14 nights) – 3 meals/day are included.

\*\$100-\$125/night for early move-in days arranged by our school off-site (based on number of days that a private room is needed, with the minimum of 14 nights; pricing will need to be confirmed based on availability of off-site accommodations) - meal costs may be extra.

As availability is limited, please contact us at your earliest convenience so we can assist you with making arrangements. All dorm students who are arriving in September must provide proof of their arrival date and time in advance. We are recommending students to plan to arrive between August 15 -20, 2020 to allow sufficient transition time within our dormitory before classes start. We have pre-determined move-in dates and times for new dorm students arriving in September (please see Important Reminders inside your Welcome Package). Please contact your Admissions Officer for more information.
