Does the school provide assistance with the admissions process?

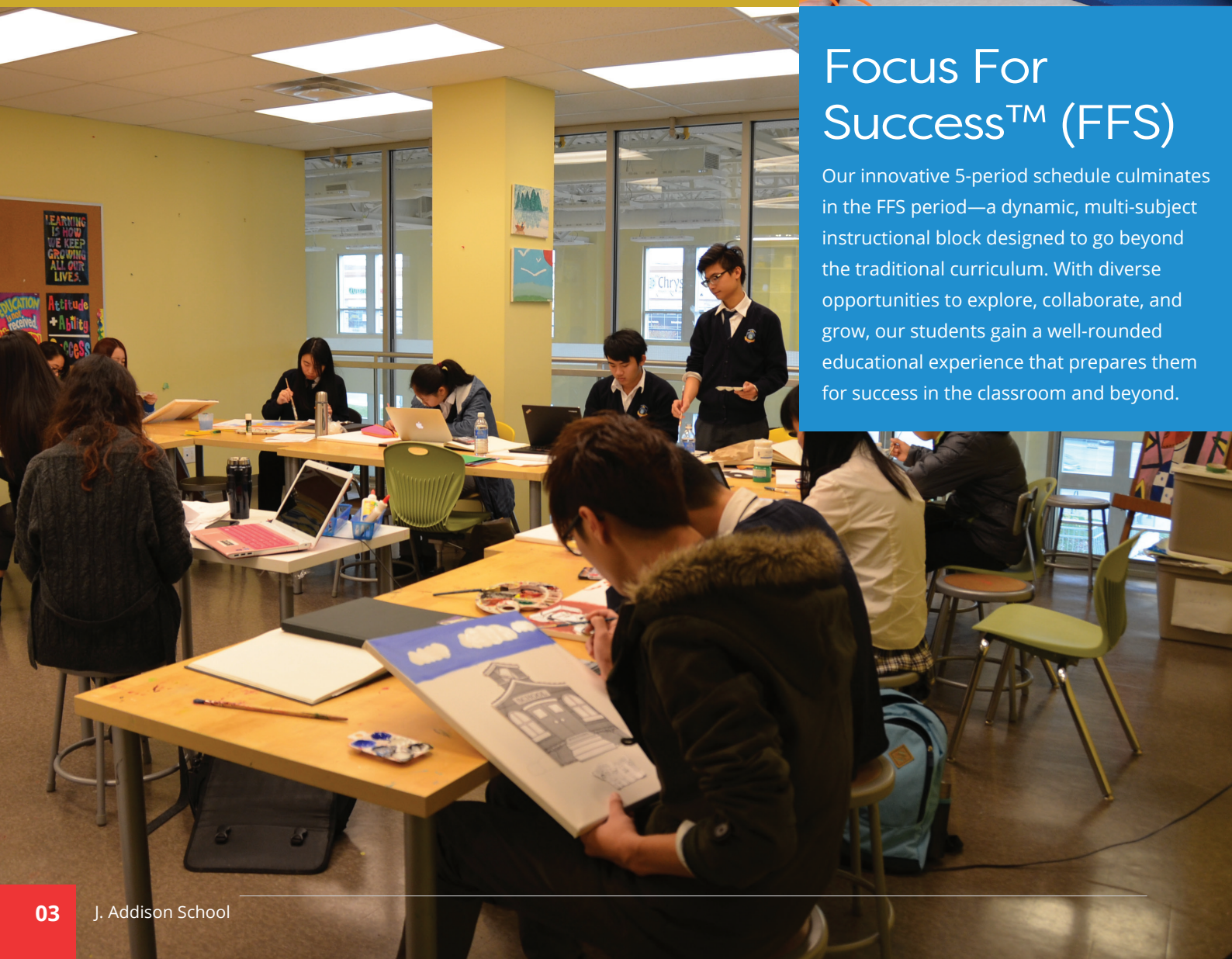

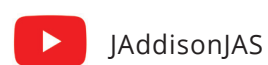
